TRIAL INFORMATION REGARDING COVID-19

MASKS ARE REQUIRED! The one exception to this is when you are in the ring running your dog—your face mask may be removed. Face mask must be put back on upon exit from the ring. Masks will not be provided. Mask must cover both nose and mouth (yeah, it has to be said)

All state, county, city or facility COVID restrictions in place on the day of the show will be strictly enforced.

All attendees will follow CDC Guidelines regarding best practice measures and will adhere to any state, local or facility protocols pertaining to COVID-19 that may be in effect on the days of the events. The club reserves the right to adjust the protocols pertaining to COVID-19 specific to these events. It is all of our responsibilities.

- DO NOT COME IF YOU FEEL SICK or have flu-like symptoms!!
- DO NOT COME if you feel uncomfortable participating in these events.
- All attendees are required to follow state, local, and facility guidelines that are in effect at the time of the events.
- You may be required to wear a mask (face covering) while in a building, as mandated by federal, state, or local guidelines. It is possible that you may not be allowed to enter a building if you are not wearing a mask, which means you will be required to wear a mask in the ring while competing with your dog. You must bring your own mask!
- Practice social distancing consistent with current guidelines. Avoid congregating to the extent possible.
- Wear masks when in close proximity to others, including when outside of a building.
- It is recommended that you avoid physical contact with others such as shaking hands or hugging, touching dogs that are not your responsibility, and common use of pens/pencils (bring your own).
- Remember to wash your hands or use hand sanitizer frequently and don't touch your mouth or eyes.
- By entering these shows you agree to abide by these guidelines and accept your own responsibility to any possible exposure to COVID-19 or any airborne diseases. If you do not abide by these guidelines, you could face a Bench Hearing or may be asked to leave the show site for the duration of these events.

- By entering these shows or attending these events, you acknowledge that an inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place where people are present and agree to hold harmless the venue, club, or superintendent liable for any illness or injury.

Please come to enjoy the shows and the ability to see old friends but be smart about your actions. Thank you for your indulgence and cooperation during these unusual times.

Any final policy changes will be included in the final confirmation.

COURSE SIZE AND SURFACE

The ring is indoors on turf. The course size is approximately 100' x 95' feet.

COURSE FAMILIARIZATION & WARM-UPS

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A walk-through period will be held prior to each class, following the Judge's Briefing.

A warm-up area consisting of a single regulation agility jump shall be provided.

Class Changes

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day. Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C -inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Fix and Go On (FNG)

As of January 1, 2020, Clubs holding agility trials will be required to offer Fix and Go On for all classes. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

MOVE-UPS

Dogs may be moved to a higher class at the request of the owner as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is made to the Trial Secretary, **no later than Monday, May 16, 2022, 6:00 p.m. MT for the Friday or Saturday Trial and by the end of the trial on Friday or Saturday for the subsequent days.** Dogs so moved will be entered at the end of the running order. **Move-ups may be sent in writing or e-mailed to the Trial Secretary.** The e-mail move-up will not be official unless acknowledged by the secretary.

JUMP HEIGHT CARDS

“Starting Jan.1, 2001, all dogs that do not have a permanent or valid temporary Jump Height Card issued by the AKC shall be measured by a judge of record prior to competing.” Please have your Jump Height card with you at the trial. Measuring of dogs without cards must take place prior to their first class.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. Judges reserve the right to measure dogs entered in any Trial. In traditional agility, dogs may, at the handler's option, be entered in a higher height division, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. In Preferred dogs must run in the division appropriate to their height. Dogs that run in a height division lower than their proper division will be eliminated.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Members of the Boston Terrier Club of America (BTCA), Raven Ranch and their agents, employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or their dogs, or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any entry fees will be made.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Bitches in season will not be admitted to nor are they allowed at the trial.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. No classes will be held up by a late exhibitor.

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. No dogs may be left tied to trees, cars, fences, etc.

Entries must reach the Trial Secretary by Friday, May 06, 2022, 6 PM (CST).

Fees must accompany all entries. Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on their entry forms. Post dated checks and returned checks will invalidate an entry with a \$25 Service Fee charged for returned checks. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.

Telephoned & unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC Entry Forms or photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules are not acceptable. No entry shall be made and no entry accepted which specifies any conditions to its acceptance.

Refunds minus judge & secretary fees per day administrative fees will be given to bitches in season if the secretary is notified within 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial each day.

VOLUNTEERS

A link will be sent out for volunteer sign up closer to the date of the trials.

OBSTACLES

Obstacles will conform to the requirements in the current edition of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials.

PARKING REGULATIONS & RV PARKING

Exhibitors must be governed by any rules & regulations of civil authorities and building & parking regulations. Vehicles parked contrary to regulations will be subject to towing at owner's expense.

Club officials may require that vehicles or equipment be rearranged to accommodate additional vehicles.

Handicap Parking will be available. Exhibitors must adhere to all parking signs.

RV Parking is not allowed on this site.

All vehicles are parked at owner's risk. BTCA and PSFD will not be responsible for loss by fire, burglary, theft, or any other causes whatsoever to the vehicle or its contents.

This is a very active doggie daycare—a strict speed limit of 5 MPH must be observed for everyone's safety.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine PartnersSM** program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler **number**, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
