Four Seasons Veterinary Specialists will be on call during these events and will also serve as the after hours emergency veterinarian, as the clinic is open 24 hours a day. Please call before going to the vet hospital.

Directions to Four Seasons Veterinary Specialists: Go southeast on Clydesdale Pkwy. toward Rodeo Dr. for 0.2 miles. Then enter roundabout and take the 2nd exit onto Clydesdale Pkwy. and go 0.3 miles. Make a U-turn at Saint Cloud Dr. onto Clydesdale Pkwy.. (If you reach Peralta Dr. you've gone a little too far.) Go 0.08 miles on Clydesdale Pkwy. Four Seasons Veterinary Specialists is on the right. (Distance 0.6 miles; estimated travel time: 2 minutes.)

Important Covid-19 Guidelines

All attendees will follow CDC guidelines regarding best practice measures and will adhere to any state, county, local, or facility protocols pertaining to COVID-19 that may be in effect on the days of the events. The club reserves the right to adjust the protocols pertaining to COVID-19 specific to these events. It is the responsibility of all of us to make every effort to ensure that everyone is able to safely enjoy these events.

- * DO NOT COME IF YOU FEEL SICK or have flu-like symptoms!
- * DO NOT COME if you feel uncomfortable participating in these events.
- * **All attendees are required** to follow state, county, local, and facility guidelines that are in effect at the time of the events.
- * You may be required to wear a mask (face covering) while in a building, as mandated by federal, state, local, or facility guidelines. Directions: From DIA, go north on Pena Blvd. toward Shady Grove St. for 1.04 miles, then take Pena Blvd. toward Valet & Short Term Parking/Arrivals and go 1.27 miles. Turn slightly right to stay on Pena Blvd. and go 3.25 miles.

Merge onto E-470 N via Exit 6B toward Boulder/Fort Collins, and go 18.4 miles.

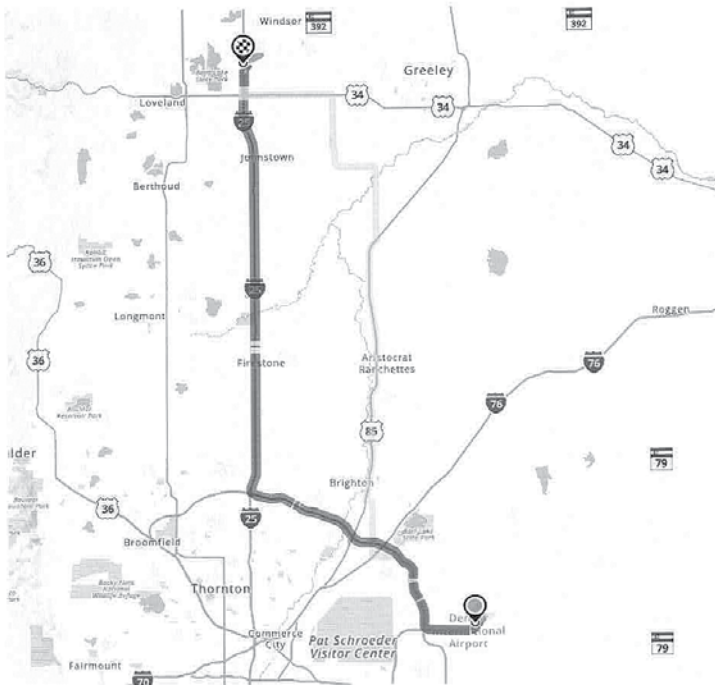
Merge onto I-25 N/US 87 N via Exit 47 toward Fort Collins and go 31.57 miles.

NR1.08100.15000. Veteran Classes - Class for dogs & class for bitches seven (7) years and over. Winners of these classes will be eligible for Best of Breed Competition. Neutered dogs and spayed bitches are allowed to compete in Veteran Classes at Specialty Shows where there is no competition beyond Best of Breed.

00900. BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

NR2.09100. Stud Dog Class - Will be for Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of Get. Stud Dog only to be judged based on the merits of the Get. Get **MUST** be entered in one of the Regular Classes. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the standard for its breed.

NR2.09200. Brood Bitch Class - The same as Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog & Produce for Get.

NR2.09300. Brace Class - Two dogs of the same breed or variety and must have at least one common owner and presented by a maximum of two handlers. - The dogs comprising a Brace **MUST** be named at time of entry. If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class Only". In making entries for "Brace Class Only," full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as a part of a Brace **MUST** be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes, "Brace Class." If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace must be so designated, "Brace No. 1," "Brace No. 2," etc. *As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch & Brace Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed or Variety by virtue of having won these classes.*

Junior Handlers **ARE REQUIRED TO TRANSFER** their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class or Open Class to Master Class **MUST NOTIFY** the Superintendent/Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

AKC Junior Handler Numbers are required for entry in Junior Showmanship Competition. Numbers may be obtained from the American Kennel Club - PHONE: (919) 233-9767.

Entry blank MUST be filled out with the necessary information, otherwise the entry in Junior Showmanship will not be accepted.

NOVICE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class or a first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition at a licensed or member show.

OPEN CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class or a first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition at a licensed or member show. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Open Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

ATTENTION OWNERS/EXHIBITORS OF FOREIGN REGISTERED DOGS

If you are the owner/exhibitor of a dog registered with a foreign registry (not yet dual registered with AKC) please review the eligibility requirements in The Rules Applying to Dog Shows, chapter 11 section 1.

Most important to note are the following:

1. Dogs must be individually registered with the American Kennel Club by the day of the event to be eligible for exhibit in the Bred by Exhibitor class.
2. Dogs are eligible to compete in AKC events using the foreign registration for a period of 30 days. That 30-day period begins with the date of first exhibit, *regardless of whether the dog earned any points or awards*. To continue to compete in AKC events beyond the initial 30-day period the dog must be either individually AKC registered or by the date of the event have been granted an extension to exhibit using the foreign registration. The owner or agent can request an extension using the form found on the AKC Web site at: <http://images.akc.org/pdf/extenap.pdf>
