Host Hotel Rules:

Having a great hotel to host our National is a privilege. Let's all be respectful and adhere to the following hotel rules:

1. All dogs left unattended in hotel guest rooms must be crated.
2. Plastic must be under all crates.
3. No more than six (6) dogs in a room.
4. Housekeepers will NOT have to service rooms in which dogs are loose and unattended. Additionally, they are required to report this rule violation to hotel management and rooms with loose dogs will be charged a higher pet fee in addition to any assessments for damage or destruction to the room, including, but not limited to, damage to sheets, towels, floors/carpets, walls, and furniture.
5. There shall be no bathing or grooming of dogs in the hotel rooms. Dogs will be bathed only in designated areas for dog washing. Any evidence of dog bathing/grooming in the hotel rooms will be assessed an excessive room cleaning fee.
6. Dogs are not permitted in any of the hotel recreation areas, including swimming pools, food & beverage areas, or any other "non-dog" area.
7. All dog waste must be picked up by the dog owner/handler and put in the provided trash receptacles. Doggy/poop bags will be provided.
8. Convention Center doors must be closed during event hours for the safety of the dogs. The facility takes NO responsibility to ensure doors remain closed.

9. No exercise pens are permitted around the front of Royal Canin Ring or the Holiday Inn Hotel and exercise pens around the perimeter of the entire building are strongly discouraged. Failure to adhere to the above rules will be deemed abuse of a hotel facility, and as such, falls within the guidelines of "Dealing with Misconduct," which may also result in a Show Bench Committee Hearing, immediate dismissal from the show, or both.

Attention Exhibitors:

Exhibitor/Attendee Agreement: By reading the BTCA's show packet, this premium list, or simply attending the events, you acknowledge and agree to be responsible for your conduct and the conduct of your dog(s) and family. Disrespectful language and behavior will result in immediate dismissal from the show site by the Show Chair.

Adequate grooming space will be provided. Exhibitors are encouraged to have dogs to the show ring area only immediately before and after judging of their class. No animals may be left overnight in the grooming room. The grooming room will be locked and not accessible after show hours.

Well-behaved dogs in crates or trollies will be allowed in designated areas of the Ballroom during the show. Crates and trollies must not obstruct easy entry/exit of the show rings or the view of spectators seated ringside. The BTCA, BTCGC & BTCD each reserves the right to require removal of dogs that are disruptive and/or distracting to judges, exhibitors, or spectators.

Grooming/Crating Space: Exhibitors may set up in the grooming/crating area after 2:00 P.M. Sunday, May 28, 2023. Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following Best of Breed judging on Friday.

CRATE STACKING IS MANDATORY. CRATES MUST BE MARKED WITH CONTACT NAME AND CELL PHONE NUMBER FOR EMERGENCIES. No crates are allowed in aisles. The Show Committees reserve the right to remove crates of anyone not adhering to these guidelines. No exercise pens are allowed in any building. No mats, play pens, or double strollers.

There is no cost, but space reservations are required no later than May 3, 2023.

AKC National Owner-Handled Series

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form.

Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner.

NR1.08100.20800. Veteran Classes - Class for dogs & class for bitches 7 years & under 10 years.

NR1.08100.37100. Veteran Classes - Class for dogs & class for bitches 10 years & over.

Winners of these classes will be eligible for Best of Breed Competition if they are undefeated in any other class.

Note: Neutered dogs or spayed bitches **MAY** be entered in Veteran Classes.

00900. BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

NR2.09100. Stud Dog Class - For Stud Dogs and maximum of two Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog must be entered separately in one of the Regular or Non-Regular Classes or if a Champion of Record, for Best of Breed Competition or Obedience Class. The Get MUST be entered in one of the Regular Classes. The Stud Dog unit shall be considered as one entry and requires only one entry fee. The Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and shown in the ring with his Get. Get only to be judged on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC Policy or the Standard for the Breed.

NR2.09200. Brood Bitch Class - Same as for Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

NR2.09300. Brace Class - A Brace is defined as two dogs of the same recognized breed that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in Brace Competition must have at least one common owner. The dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at the time of entry. Dog MUST be entered in another class and Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes - "Brace Class." If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace unit must be so designated - "Brace No. 1," "Brace No. 2," etc. **PLEASE SUBMIT BRACE ENTRIES TOGETHER.**

NR2.09400. Team Class - A Team is defined as four dogs of the same recognized breed that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of four handlers. All dogs competing in Team Competition must have at least one common owner. The dogs comprising a Team MUST be named at the time of entry. Dog MUST be entered in another class and Team MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes - "Team Class." If more than one Team is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising EACH Team must be so designated - "Team No. 1," "Team No. 2," etc. **PLEASE SUBMIT TEAM ENTRIES TOGETHER.**

As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Brace & Team Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, none of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition present or a first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show, **ARE REQUIRED TO TRANSFER** their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class. **MUST NOTIFY** the Superintendent/Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

NOVICE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places in a Novice Junior Showmanship Class with competition present at a licensed or member show.

OPEN CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places in a Novice Junior Showmanship Class with competition present at a licensed or member show.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

ATTENTION OWNERS/EXHIBITORS OF FOREIGN REGISTERED DOGS

If you are the owner/exhibitor of a dog registered with a foreign registry (not yet dual registered with AKC) please review the eligibility requirements in The Rules Applying to Dog Shows, chapter 11 section 1.

The dog show rules are posted on the AKC Web site at: <http://images.akc.org/pdf/rulebooks/RREGS3.pdf>

Most important to note are the following:

1. Dogs must be individually registered with the American Kennel Club by the day of the event to be eligible for exhibit in the Bred by Exhibitor class.
2. Dogs are eligible to compete in AKC events using the foreign registration for a period of 30 days. That 30-day period begins with the date of first exhibit, *regardless of whether the dog earned any points or awards*. To continue to compete in AKC events beyond the initial 30-day period the dog must be either individually AKC registered or by the date of the event have been granted an extension to exhibit using the foreign registration. Telegraph, Telephone (Except Dial-N-Entry®) and Unsigned Entries Cannot Be Accepted. Entries Not On Official AKC Entry Forms, Downloaded and/or Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

Fax Entries, 1-336-272-0864 or 1-800-SHO-FAXS. Both sides of entry form must be transmitted. Entries must be accompanied by a cover sheet stating the number of pages, what shows and how many dogs per show. Visa/Mastercard/Discover/American Express number and expiration date, as well as the printed cardholder's name and address must be included on cover sheet. Visa/Mastercard/Discover/American Express number, expiration date and cardholder's name must appear on each entry. Fax entries must be received by the closing hour/date. Fax fee: \$4.50 per entry in addition to entry fee. All credit card entries, regardless of method submitted, are processed through the Fax program and are charged the \$4.50 administrative fee. This Fax Fee is subject to change without notice.

Make All Checks and Money Orders payable to MB-F, Inc. **CANADIAN/FOREIGN** exhibitors must make fees payable in U.S. FUNDS. Post Dated Checks, Returned Checks and Declined Credit Cards do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Event Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check or declined card. Subsequent returned checks or declined cards from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a **CASH ONLY** basis.

CHARGEBACKS on Credit Cards are considered a violation of your agreement to pay the required entry fee for entry into a show and the AKC Compliance Dept. will be notified for their disciplinary action. Also, if this remains a bad debt, the club may decline future entries for their shows and the superintendent will decline future entries for ANY show submitted via any method of payment until the debt is paid (Chap 11, Sec 15, AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows). Thereafter, the superintendent will refuse all future credit card entries from the exhibitor. All future entries must be paid for in cash or by money order or check.

An AKC Recording Fee of \$5.00 first entry only and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.50 will be required for each first entry and \$3.00 each additional entry in any Licensed or Member Club Rally Trial. An AKC Event Service Fee of \$2.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered at any Open Show. All Recording and Event Service Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club. **(There is no Recording Fee or Event Service Fee for Junior Showmanship, Sweepstakes, Futurities, Brace/Team, Multi-Dog Classes or Special Attractions.)**

No Entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. If because of riots, wars, strikes, civil disturbances, national emergencies, health emergencies, and the dictates of law enforcement or of the owner(s) of the grounds and/or facilities or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the event, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, heavy rains, or other circumstances including, but not limited to, the condition of the facilities or grounds and/or the ingress and egress from the grounds, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the event before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made. To find out about any AKC event cancellations call the AKC Event Cancellation Hotline (877) 252-3229.

No Refund for Duplicate Entries. Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made; however, if entry has been processed, no refund will be made. **An Administrative Fee of \$4.00 will be charged or withheld from refunds for duplicate entries.**

An Administrative Fee of \$4.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.

Errors on Entry Blanks. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

Each Owner and Agent listed on the entry form and/or individual responsible for the dog at a show is bound by the Certification and Agreement on the front and back of the entry form regardless of who may have completed & submitted the entry form.

As specified in Chapter 12, Section 4 of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, information contained on the entry form is required to be published in the club's show catalog. This information is also subject to publication in other media.

Dogs May Arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. **Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.**

Judges Will Not Wait for Any Dog Holding Up a Class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

All Dogs Present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

Class Cash Prizes will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over, and the Event Secretary's Office advised at once. The Event Secretary and Show-Giving Club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.

No gasoline or diesel generators are permitted inside any building or within 100 feet of any tent in which this dog show is conducted.

HOW TO USE THE ENTRY BLANK

Use one entry blank per dog only if information is exactly the SAME for each event. Carefully check the block (blocks) for each event in which you wish to enter your dog. You MUST use a SEPARATE entry blank if you are entering your dog in a different class on different events.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name.
